ITS is pleased to announce that, as a result of a generous gift from an alumnus, wireless network access will be expanded campuswide beginning in the 2007-2008 academic year. This expansion will also include a significant enhancement to the security of information transmitted wirelessly. You will use your existing username and password to connect to the wireless network, the same way you currently do to access other Hamilton resources.

Highlight of the Project Include...

1. Coverage to almost all indoor and outdoor areas of campus.
2. Secure transmission of information for members of the Hamilton community.
3. Limited "open/unsecured" access in some public areas for visitors.

How to Connect...

Once you are on campus instructions will be available on the ITS website or through your RA. Assistance will be available by contacting the Help Desk x4181.

What You Will Need...

Connectivity to the secure wireless network is supported by **802.11b or 802.11g cards (2.4 GHz) for your Windows** computer and **Apple Airport cards for your Apple** computer.

What You DON'T Need...

The installation of a personal wireless access point (Apple Airport Station, wireless routers, etc.) is **PROHIBITED** on campus. These devices will interfere with Hamilton's wireless network.
