In five separate instances, students were assigned **one (1)** judicial point for being disruptive in a residence hall.

A student had **150 points added to his/her lottery number** for participating in an illegal room change.

A student received **two (2)** judicial points for drug paraphernalia found in their room.

A senior who was involved in an illegal room change received **two (2)** judicial points.

In two separate instances, students received **two (2)** judicial points for violation of quiet hours.

A student received **two (2)** judicial points for violation of the smoking policy.

A student received **two (2)** judicial points for being disruptive at a men's basketball game.

A student received **three (3)** judicial points for violation of quiet hours and failure to comply with the directive of a college official.

Five students received **three (3)** points each for violation of the alcohol policy and being disruptive.

A student received **three (3)** judicial points for failure to evacuate during a fire alarm.

Two students received **three (3)** judicial points each for possession of a pellet gun.

A student received **three (3)** judicial points for being disruptive at a men's hockey game.

A student received **three (3)** judicial points for being disruptive and consuming alcohol at a Hamilton College men's hockey game at the Clinton Arena.

A student received **three (3)** judicial points for urinating in public.

A student who was with other students smoking marijuana received **three (3)** judicial points.

In seven separate incidents, students received **four (4)** judicial points for possession or use of marijuana.

In two separate instances, students received **four (4)** points for violation of the residence hall pet policy.

A student received **four (4)** points for hosting a party and providing alcohol in a residence hall.

Four students received **four (4)** points each for theft of fire wood from an off-campus farm.

Two students received **five (5)** points each for violation of the pet policy and failure to comply with the directive of a college official.

A student received **six (6)** judicial points for tampering with a smoke detector.

In two separate instances, two students, who accepted responsibility for damage they caused, received **six (6)** judicial points and were charged double the cost of repair.

Two students who were social hosts for a registered party received **six (6)** points for serving more alcohol than was approved for the event.

A student received **six (6)** points for firing a pellet gun in a residence hall.

Two students who live in an apartment in the Village of Clinton were arrested by Kirkland Police and received **eight (8)** points for hosting a party and serving alcohol to minors.

A student received **eight (8)** points for covering the smoke detector and smoking in his/her room.

A student who was arrested for driving while intoxicated was **suspended** for two semesters.
