

## Linking to Specific Pages in the RefWorks Help

Did you know that you can link to specific pages in the RefWorks online help from your own website? This can be especially useful if you want to link to our Data Vendor-specific import instructions or any other set of instructions we have in our documentation.

### Here's how you do it:

1. Open the **RefWorks Help** file.
2. Locate the topic title you wish to link to (for this example, we will use the topic called **Exporting from a Data Service**).
3. Right mouse click on the topic name and select **Properties**.
4. The properties window will open. Copy the **Address (URL)** information that is displayed.
5. You will need to paste the URL into a program that will allow you to modify it (like a word processing software, Notepad, etc.).
6. You will need to add some information to the URL to make the link work. Here's the URL for our topic example:

[http://www.refworks.com/Refworks/help/Exporting\\_from\\_Data\\_Services\\_and\\_Importing\\_into\\_RefWorks.htm](http://www.refworks.com/Refworks/help/Exporting_from_Data_Services_and_Importing_into_RefWorks.htm)

Notice that every URL will start with <http://www.refworks.com/RefWorks/help/> and it will follow with the topic name.

7. In every URL that you copy from the help file, you need to add **RefWorks.htm#** following the "[http://www.refworks.com/RefWorks/help/...](http://www.refworks.com/RefWorks/help/)" and before the topic name.

So our new URL that we can link to becomes:

[http://www.refworks.com/Refworks/help/Refworks.htm#Exporting\\_from\\_Data\\_Services\\_and\\_Importing\\_into\\_RefWorks.htm](http://www.refworks.com/Refworks/help/Refworks.htm#Exporting_from_Data_Services_and_Importing_into_RefWorks.htm)
